EMPIRE BUILDERS

EMPIRE, DESCRIBED AS ONE of the most complex board games in existence, has found a home in Winch Hall in the Reed College Main Dormitory.

Invented 30 years ago by Stillman Drake and introduced at Reed by his son, Dan, four years ago, the complicated board is permanently set up in Winch except during

Summer and Christmas vacations.

The game is set on a board about 4 by 5 feet. It involves imaginary countries (Trantor, Kalgan, Chaldrisan Federation) and their populations, resources, cities and factories. Hundreds of plastic and wood figures represent resources and strength of each country. The surface is covered with a plastic overlay.

As many as 12 students can play simultaneously. Eight students are playing the game currently in progress.


Players usually complete two games. Moves are made at the student's convenience and are sometimes made after several days of deliberation. Players sometimes confer with others and moves are occasionally sandwiched between classes.

The object is to remain in the game as long as possible and to prevent other countries from encroaching on one's territory.

Empire devotees say that it takes about a week for beginners to become proficient. Novices are sometimes apprenticed to


